The Path Forward

In 2019, the Province of Manitoba mandated the Winnipeg Metropolitan Region (WMR) with the unique and important responsibility to coordinate the first draft of Plan20-50. To deliver on our mandate, the WMR engaged a team of independent experts to lead the draft plan development process.

The goal of a regional plan is to provide long term vision to guide land use and servicing, to improve and coordinate service delivery, to reduce competition between municipalities, and to ensure investment in infrastructure is prioritized to support a strong regional economy. Competitive metro regions across Canada and the globe create regional plans to:

- Ensure long-term supply of serviced residential, commercial, and industrial land;
- Direct, prioritize, and facilitate investment in infrastructure;
- Provide confidence for investment;
- Ensure service delivery to residents and businesses is effective and efficient well into the future;
- Ensure the protection of agricultural land;
- Protect freshwater resources;
- Build resilience to flooding and drought and the effects of a changing climate.

Timeline

The Draft Plan20-50 process to date:

January - September 2020	Conducted research and engagement to identify policy areas and direction
September - February 2021	Refined policy areas, best practice review, engagement, and developed draft policy
March 2021 -	Draft Plan refinement, engagement, presentation webinars, and the submission of Draft Plan20-50 to the Minister of Municipal Relations.
